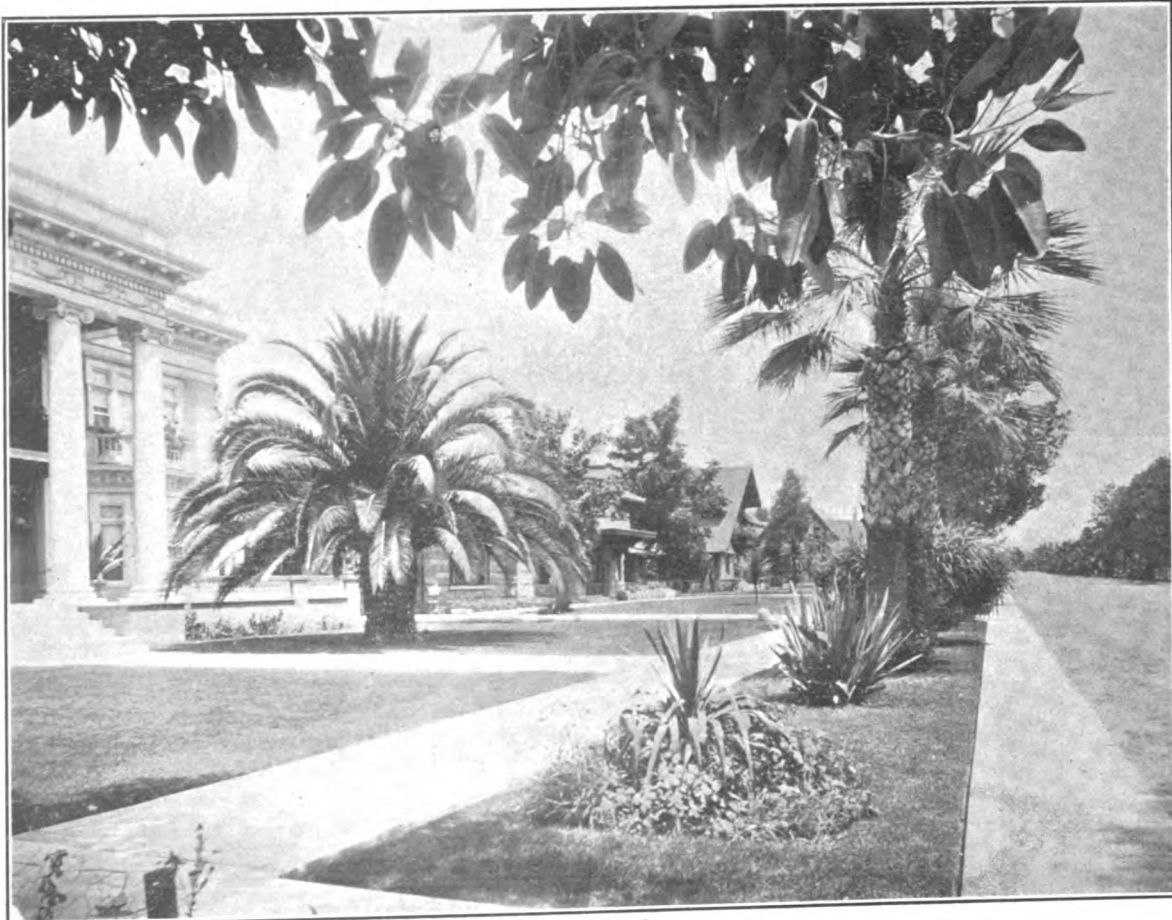

THE GOSPEL FOR FOREIGNERS.

The latest project of the Board of Publication and Sabbath School Work should be welcomed with thanksgiving by all Presbyterians. This Board proposes to employ a Slavonic colporteur in Lehigh Presbytery, and asks the General Assembly for permission to solicit funds for the extension of colportage till all our immigrants are visited who are destitute of the gospel. With God's blessing this work can be developed so that multitudes may be persuaded to buy and read the Scriptures, and the way prepared for permanent missions among them, by a more systematic and comprehensive plan than ever before. Such itineration in Presbyterian Foreign Missions has been frequent and fruitful, so that an immense saving has resulted in time, money, and precious lives; open doors have been disclosed and efforts have been made ten-fold more effective. As the Church prays for foreigners, let her remember these new heralds of the gospel and pray the Lord of the harvest that he will send forth more laborers into his harvest.

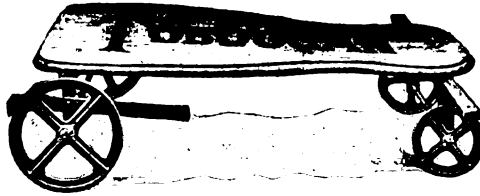
