The extant records of the Pittsgrove Presbyterian Church are written in a large folio volume seventeen inches by eleven in size, containing five hundred and fifty pages. They were copied from the original books by the Revd. I. Foster. They appear to be complete for the period covered by the incumbency of David Evans, the first pastor, from 1740 to 1751. During the second pastorate, that of the Revd. Nehemiah Greenman, 1753 to 1779, there are only minutes of Session, and these are lacking from 1753 to 1755, and from 1764 to 1779. These minutes are omitted for sufficient reasons. Following the minutes of 1764 the pages are blank from 34 to 73, or until 1802. Page 74 contains a register of members for the early years of the nineteenth century. Pages 77 to 118 are blank, but page 119 gives a tabulation of contributions to the Boards of the church, from 1859 to 1867, which is omitted. Pages 120 to 278 are also blank. This long gap is followed by "Burials by Rev. E. P. Shields," on pages 279 to 282. Pages 283 to 384 are blank. Then come "Marriages by E. P. Shields." These are succeeded by another long gap from 389 to 475. Then five pages contain baptisms, dating from February, 1806, to August, 1813. The next thirty pages, 480 to 510, are of great interest and value as they give the families of the church in separate groups, with the dates of birth and baptism of the children of these families, from 1776 to 1868. Pages 511 to 550 are blank.— J. B. T.

[Page 3.] The Church Records of the Presbyterian Congregation at Pilesgrove, begun April 30<sup>th</sup> day, In the year of our Lord 1741. By the Rev<sup>d</sup>. David Evans The first gospel Pastor there.

Be it known and remembered to and by the presbyterian congregation at Pilesgrove in Salem County, in West New Jersey That the deed of sale for the graveyard and meeting house of the said congregation, at the said place, was duly executed January 1<sup>st</sup>, 1742-3. by Lewis du Bois, and Margaret his wife unto Eliazar Smith and Jacob du Bois son of Barnet du Bois, and that at the same time The declaration of Trust and £1000 Bond of performance were duly executed by the said Eleazar and Jacob unto Henry Van Meter, Cornelius Nieukerke, Garrett du Bois, and John Rickman, of the said place.

And that all the said Writings were then delivered to the keeping of Henry Van Meter above named, to be produced whenever the above said congregation, or the major part thereof, shall have just cause to demand the perusal or delivery of the said writings.

Witness David Evans, A.M. & V. D. M. Pastor of said congregation, and faithful Eye and Ear witness to the whole transactions abovesaid. January 1<sup>st</sup> Anno Domini 1742-3.

The Church Covenant of The presbyterian Congregation at Pilesgrove. In the name of Almighty Eternal Jehovah, God the Father, Son and Holy Ghost, We who are Christian Protestants, of the presbyterian denomination inhabiting Pilesgrove, and the neighboring places in Salem County in West New Jersey, in America: Acknowledging & truly lamenting our sinful and woful state in Adam's fall: as also the manifold sins we are guilty of against God, in thoughts, words, and deeds: and believing that we can no way escape the everlasting damnation, justly due to our sins but only by receiving Jesus Christ whom God of his free mercy offereth unto all weary and heavy laden sinners that by faith accept him as he is held forth in the gospel. We do therefore, by the grace of God enabling, sincerely forsake all our sinful ways and humbly, and thankfully receive Jesus Christ, to be our only Saviour, mediator & prophet, priest, and king: according to the whole tenour of the covenant of grace. And we do hereby solemnly renew our baptismal engagement by that covenant to be the Lord's people. both we and our seed. To worship, serve and glorify him, according to his Written Word, contained in holy scriptures, as the same is briefly explained in the confession, catechisms, & directory of Christian faith and practice agreed upon by the reverend assembly of divines at Westminster. Trusting and hoping and earnestly praying that we may obtain full pardon of all our sins, sanctifying grace and eternal glory,

from the infinite free mercy of God the Father, through the perfect merits of God the Son, by the Sanctification of God the Holy Ghost. Depending entirely upon the alone merits, and continual intercession of God the Son, Jesus Christ, for the acceptance of our persons, and all our duties, now and henceforth with God. And on the continual mercy of God the Father, and the constant influences of God the Holy Ghost, to enable us to walk faithfully, according to the whole tenour of the Gospel of grace and salvation, without whom we can

do nothing, and by whom strengthening us, we shall be able to do all things that shall be pleasing in his sight, To whom be all the glory forever. Amen. And in testimony of our sincerity herein, we do most willingly set our names hereunto, at the place abovesaid, this thirtieth day of April in the year of our Lord God Jesus Christ, one thousand seven hundred and forty one.

Records of Church Discipline in the congregation of the Presbyterians at Pilesgrove in Salem County in West New Jersey, under the administration of the Reverend David Evans, A.M. & V.D.M. at the said place. June 12-1742. Elizabeth Dunlap and James Dunlap, her husband, were both debarred, & suspended, from Sealing Ordinances, & particularly from the Lord's Supper, for breach of marriage, and unchristian behaviour relating thereunto, both in words & actions.

December 4.-1742. Robert Holbrook being accused of

drunkenness was debarred from the Lord's Table this time, till his case be enquired into and considered.

December 9.-1742. Upon inquiry into the case of the above-said Robert Holbrook, it was found by several evidences, that he had drink'd too much, which was manifest by his staggering and falling & smelling strong of Rum: and his own confessing that he had drank an excessive quantity of Rum that day. But upon his professing repentance, and promising future amendment He was rebuked, admonished, and warned, and so continued in his Church priveleges.

February 5. 1742.3. Complaint being brought that the above mentioned Robert Holbrook had again behaved unbecoming the gospel Rules, and he not appearing, He was debarred from the Lord's Table till his case be tried

April 2, 1743, It being reported that the abovesaid Robert Holbrook has gone away clandestinely from this province, thereupon we reckon & conclude that he hath forsaken us.

July 26-1743. Harman Richman complaining that Isaac Van Meter, at the public house of Obadiah Lloyd, had lately before company, abused him, by abusive, railing threatening words, and raging behaviour. It appeared upon examination of the case, partly by confession of the said Isaac, as well as by the evidence of several witnesses, That the said Isaac, in some angry discourse with the said Harman, did call the said Harman several times an old aggravating dog, and a cursed old devil, & that he would (or had a mind to) have the heart-blood of the said Harman, and in a continued raging, provoking, threatening manner, holding out his fists to, or toward the face of the said Harman: threatening to lick or beat him, with more such like expressions, & ragious behaviour. Now the said Isaac being a member in full communion, and looked upon to be one chief leading man of our christian congregation, whose profession, age, and gray hairs, should have influenced him to be an example of Christian behaviour, to all

about him: That he should let himself loose, as abovesaid to use the hellish Language, and postures, of the most profane, of the vilest of men, and that in such a public place and manner, to the dishonor of God, scandal of the Christian Religion; shame and grief of serious christians, and the opening the mouth of the wicked, to blaspheme the name of God, his holy ways & people, and thereby to harden themselves in their wicked ways to their perdition.—Therefore as our Lord Jesus Christ the King of his Church, hath numbered *revilers and railers*, with the vilest of sinners, & hath forbidden his church *to eat with them* (I Cor. 6, 9. 10, with chapter 5-11, 12, 13,) So by the authority of the Lord Jesus, we do debar, the said Isaac Van

—[Page 6.]—Meter from the Lord's Table, that we maintain the Holiness of God in his house, and may see what signs of Gospel humiliation, and repentance will appear in our said Brother, in order to his restoration to his church priveleges. And let this awful act of the Lord Jesus, in his house, make us all tremble, so as to cry day and night for grace to enable us always everywhere, to behave in all things, as becometh the holy gospel, and holy Laws of our Saviour & Lord Jesus Christ amen. And let us know that this is not excommunication, but only a suspension. Therefore, let us pray for the suspended, as the Word of God requireth and directeth. 2 Thessalonians 3.6.14-15.

October 1:1743. Isaac Van Meter being abroad, about Potowmack in Virginia, his suspension was continued.

December 3. 1743. Isaac Van Meter not appearing in due time, according to warning given, his suspension was continued.

January 26-1743.-4. Isaac Van Meter upon his public humiliation, and promise of walking becoming the Gospel, was restored to his former Church priveleges.—

At a meeting of the presbyterian congregation of Piles-



grove, Jan<sup>y</sup> 5. 1748-9. were chosen—Isaac Van Meter, Barnet du Bois, William Alderman, Eliazar Smith,—for ruling Elders—and Jacob du Bois, Sen<sup>r</sup> Abraham Nieu Kirk, for deacons—and Joseph Tossy for gravedigger. And also it was concluded that three shillings was sufficient for digging every grave.—And be it remembered that the above choice was only upon trial, & that only for one year—

1755. April 9. 1755. Session met according to appointment. Present. Rev<sup>d</sup> Nehemiah Greenman, Elders Jacob du Bois and Abraham Nieu Kirk. (deacons) Jacob du Bois, Jr. Absent, William Alderman. After prayer we proceeded with John Richman, who was accused of going to a wizard in Philadelphia, and giving him money to tell where his servant was, or when he would come home &c. which was a public report. We conversed with him freely, and endeavored to get all the light possible: and it is our judgement, that altho' the report may be false, yet we cannot clear him until he proves it to be so by evidence which he promised to do by our next session. He was also accused of neglecting family prayer, which he confessed and promised to satisfy us at our next Session. He was also accused of being delinquent in supporting the Gospel according to obligation; but promised to pay all his arrearages from the time of Mr. Greenman's coming: He was also accused of speaking imprudently, before other people of different persuasion, about some of Mr. Greenman's Sermons: But gave us no satisfaction in this particular. James Davies present, who was accused to us by Mr Hunter, of allowing frolicking, and bad company, and neglecting family prayer, which he promised to clear up by the next Session.

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### LIFE OF ALEXANDER HENDERSON.

BY JOSEPH MINTON BATTEN.

PART I (1583-1637).

The sixteenth and seventeenth centuries were times of fierce religious conflict. This statement is especially true in regard to the loosely governed and tumultuous nation of Scotland. The conflicts which followed the introduction of the Reformation into Scotland are marked by two distinct periods. In the first period (1560-1572) the struggle was between old Romanism and nascent Protestantism. In the second period which began in 1572, the struggle was between Presbytery and Prelacy. John Knox was the hero of the first period. Alexander Henderson was the guiding spirit of the second. The two men who have best understood Henderson's life work recognize this fact in their summary of his position in the history of the religious life of Scotland. Principal Baillie says of him: "he ought to be accounted by us and posterity the fairest ornament, after John Knox, of incomparable memory, that we the Church of Scotland did enjoy."<sup>1</sup> And Aiton, his biographer, says of him: "so long as the purity of our Presbyterian Establishment remains—as often as the General Assembly of our Church is permitted to convene—while the Confessions of Faith, and Catechisms, Larger and Shorter,
